Maison Dali Expands Luxury Dining With Commission-Only Chef's Canvas Concept

Maison Dali, located within Business Bay at The Opus, has introduced Chef's Canvas, a commission-based fine dining format designed around fully personalized culinary experiences. The concept operates outside traditional reservation and menu-driven restaurant systems and focuses on individually commissioned dining experiences for small private groups. Each service is created following direct consultation with Tristin Farmer, who previously led the



occasions in Dubai.

Chef's Canvas and Its Commission-Based Dining Structure

Chef's Canvas functions through a structured commissioning model rather than a published menu format. Each dining experience is designed as a standalone commission, resulting in a customized multi-course sequence ranging from eight to fifteen courses. No menu is reused across different commissions, and each service is planned exclusively for the commissioning guests.

The commissioning process follows five defined stages. These include an initial inquiry outlining preferred dates and guest details, followed by a two-hour consultation conducted directly with Chef Farmer. During this phase, dietary requirements, flavor preferences, cultural considerations, and thematic expectations are outlined. Based on these inputs, a customized menu architecture is developed. Ingredient sourcing is conducted through international supply networks over a preparation window of seven to fourteen days, after which the experience is executed as planned.

Unlike conventional fine dining operations that serve multiple tables with identical menus, Chef's Canvas operates with a single table per evening. Each service is limited to one commissioned group, ensuring no overlap in menus, themes, or service structures between different evenings.

travel experiences centered on personal milestones rather than standardized itineraries. Travelers increasingly seek dining experiences that reflect individual preferences and personal narratives during international visits. The commission-based format allows visiting guests to integrate dining into broader travel plans focused on celebrations, private gatherings, or intimate experiences.

The structure allows guests to approach dining as a planned event rather than a spontaneous reservation. For travelers visiting Dubai for limited durations, this format enables advance coordination and tailored experiences that align with the purpose of the trip. The model supports flexibility in pacing, guest interaction, and menu composition without reliance on fixed service templates.

Private Dining as a Component of Luxury Tourism

Private dining formats have become an integral element of luxury tourism experiences, particularly for travelers prioritizing exclusivity and personalization. Commission-based dining allows visitors to engage with local culinary offerings while maintaining privacy and control over the dining narrative.

For tourists, such formats remove the constraints associated with standard restaurant operations, including fixed menus and shared dining spaces. Instead, the experience is framed as a dedicated event, complementing travel itineraries built around exclusivity, discretion, and individualized planning.

Operational Distinction From Traditional Fine

Dining

Chef's Canvas intentionally operates without several features common to fine dining establishments. There is no published menu, no walk-in access, and no public-facing digital archive of past services. Experiences are not repeated, photographed, or publicly documented, maintaining privacy for commissioning guests.

Chef Farmer maintains direct involvement across all stages of each commission. This includes conducting consultations, designing menus, sourcing ingredients, and presenting each course during service. This continuity distinguishes the concept from restaurant models where responsibilities are distributed across multiple teams.

Dual Dining Structure at Maison Dali

Maison Dali operates two distinct dining formats within the same venue. The primary restaurant functions as a relaxed fine dining establishment offering Mediterranean-Japanese fusion cuisine with a published menu and seating capacity for 60 guests. Pricing for this offering ranges between AED 130 and AED 600 per person.

Chef's Canvas operates separately as a private dining concept, with pricing starting at AED 10,000 per guest for standard groupings. The experience accommodates groups ranging from two to eight guests and is hosted in a dedicated private space within the venue.

This dual structure allows Maison Dali to cater simultaneously to general fine dining visitors and travelers

Requirements

Guests interested in commissioning Chef's Canvas initiate contact by submitting preferred dates, guest numbers, and occasion details. A consultation session is then scheduled directly with Chef Farmer. Following consultation, menu development and ingredient sourcing take place over a recommended preparation period of up to fourteen days.

The experience is executed on the agreed date, with all planning completed in advance. The model prioritizes preparation and coordination over spontaneous booking, aligning with travel planning practices commonly associated with luxury tourism experiences.
